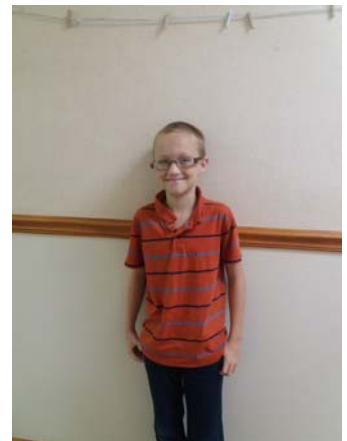
We are gearing up for our first set of parent-teacher conferences. Parents will be meeting with the teaching staff to discuss their student's academic progress thus far.
