Wow! Another week is gone! We were blessed last Friday to be able to have an interactive chapel, with discussions of encouragement and a reminder of how important truth and honesty are when we interact with each other.

We did not have projects this week, because of our cancelled Fall Break, so we were able to have a special celebration time. For art we did a 3-D line project to learn about tracing and the appearance of depth and spacing.

For science, upper graders were able to dissect Oysters and learn about the mollusks and their life in the wild. We even drew diagrams about what we were able to see firsthand. 
