Our school is a place where children learn about Christ's second coming, where we study our Bibles each day, study Jesus' behavior, and 'stand in the gap' between heaven and the world. We reject worldliness, and embrace each other in agape love. Our sheltered environment helps cultivate soil for God's love to be planted.
